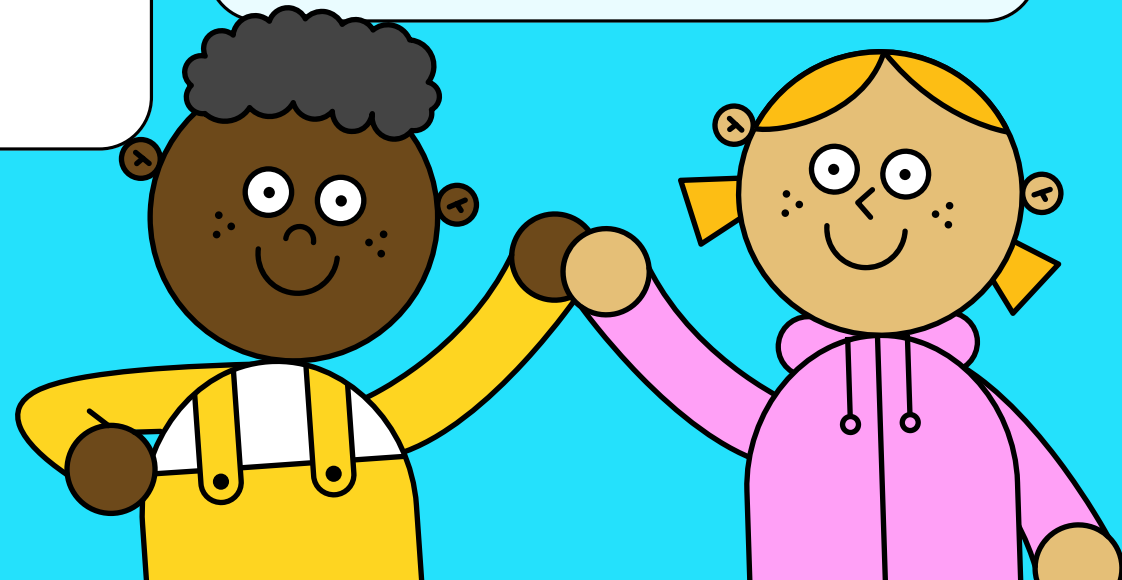

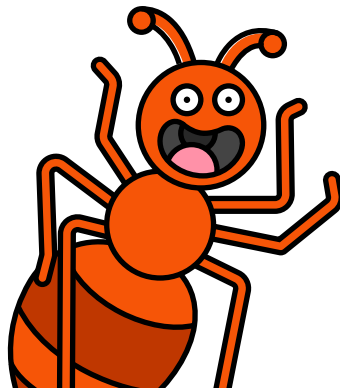
Read the presentation '**What are the Global Goals?**'.

Animals and people all need...



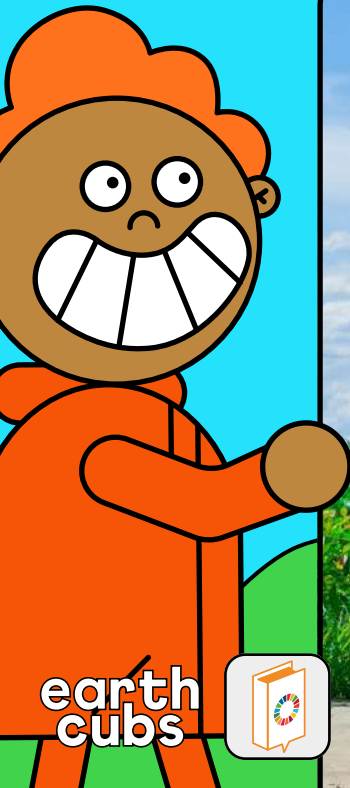
Even though all these animals and people are very different.

I will share my ants!



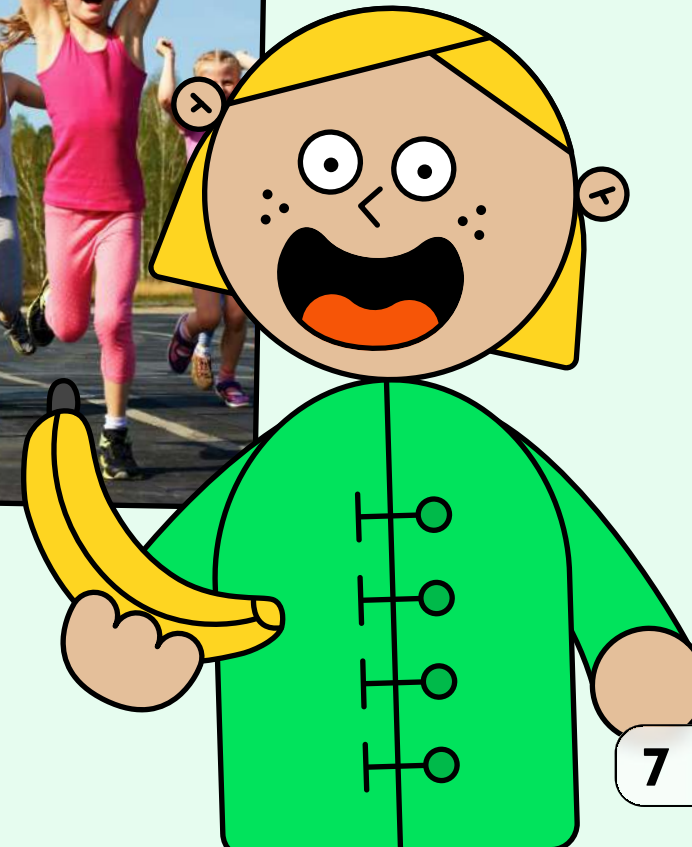


Earth Cubs believe in healthy body and mind.

Earth Cubs believe everyone should have clean water.

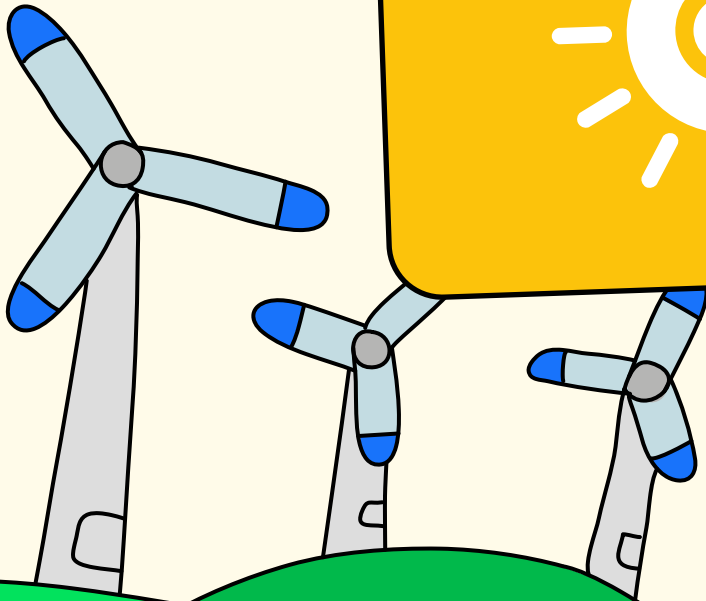
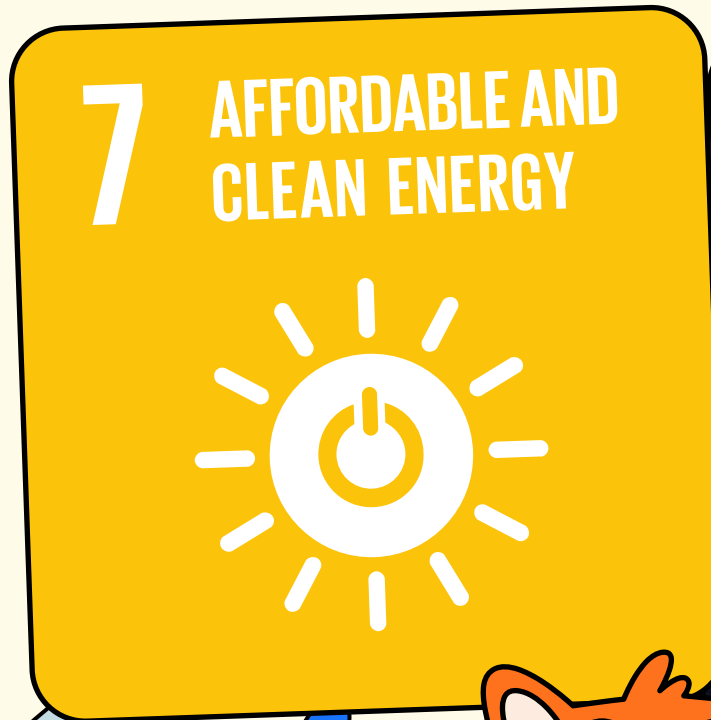

Earth Cubs care about climate change.



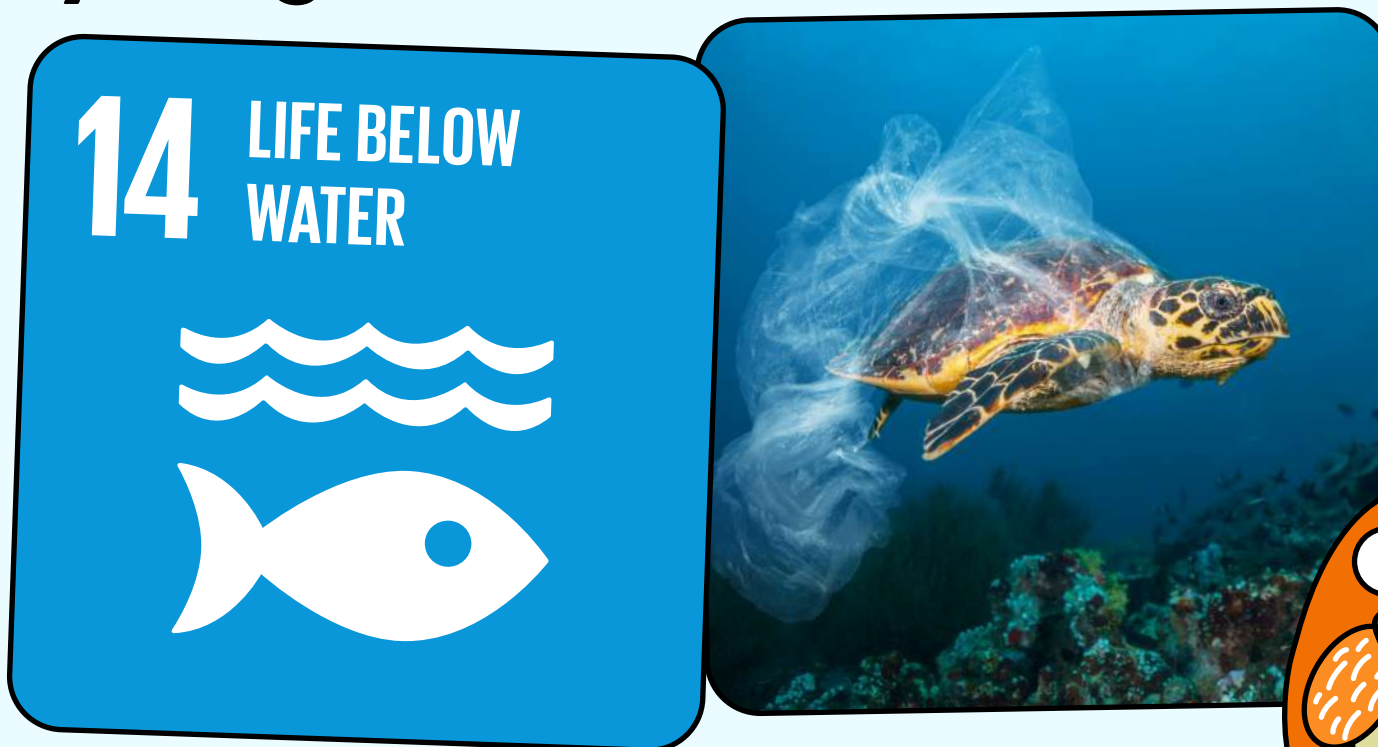

Earth Cubs look after the seas and everything in it.

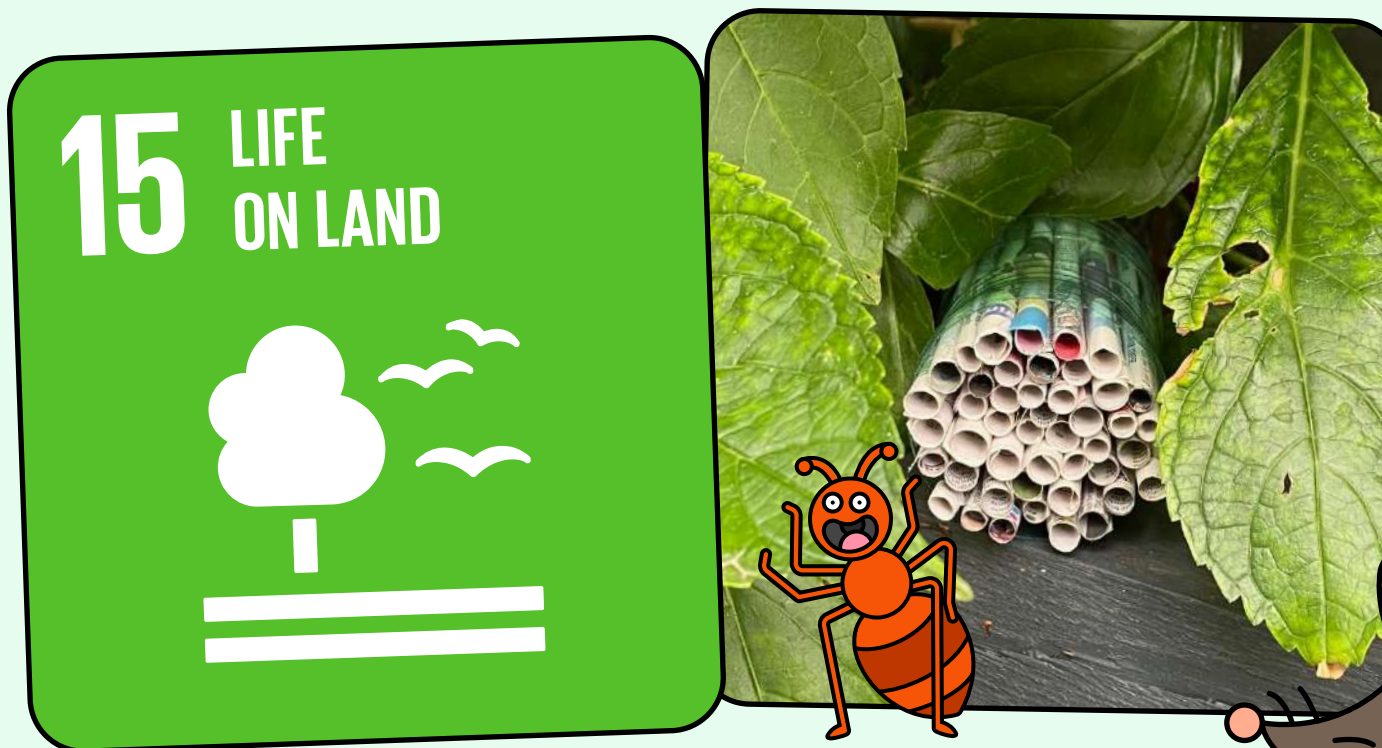


Rubbish can end up in our oceans which can hurt my friends.

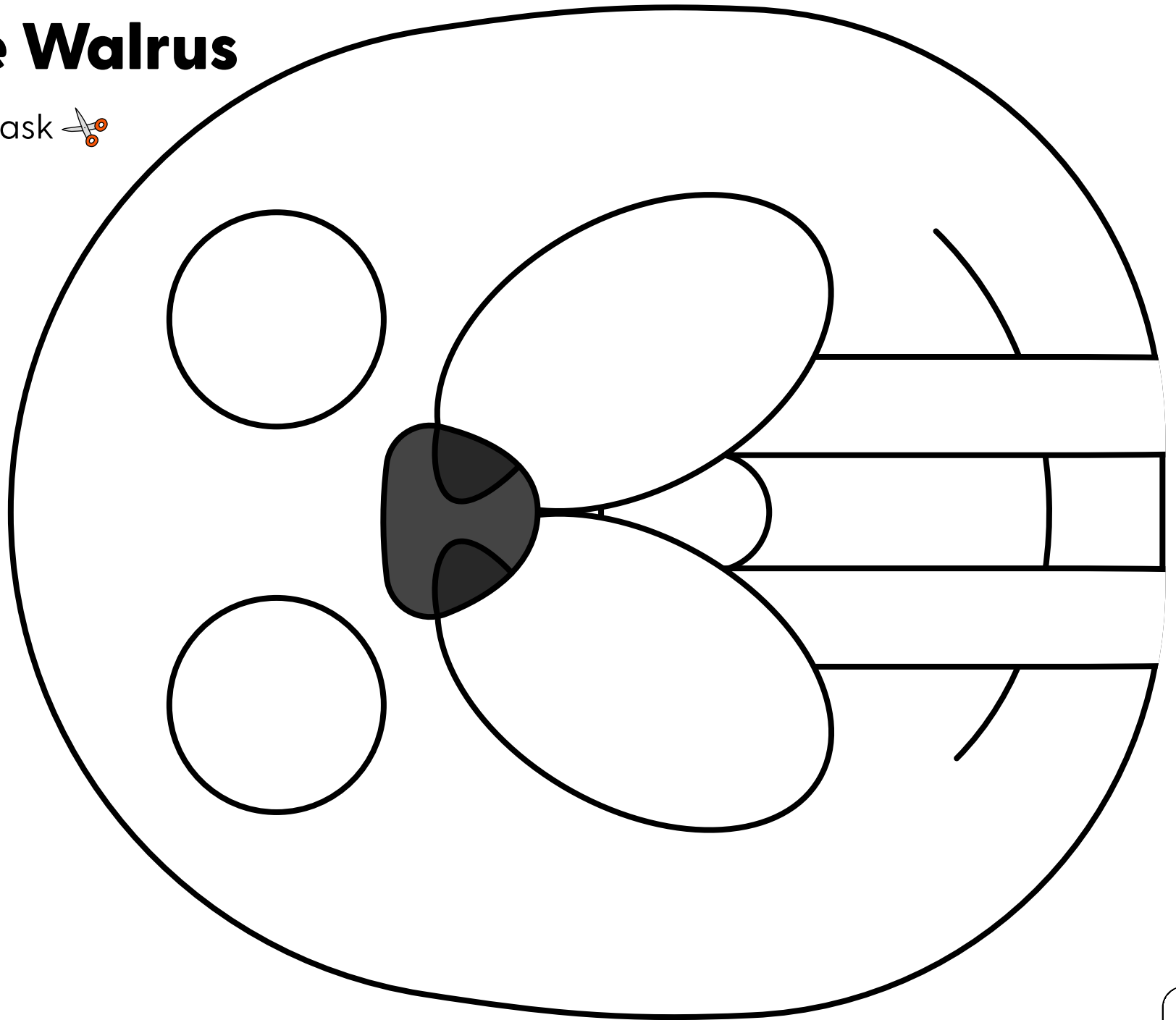

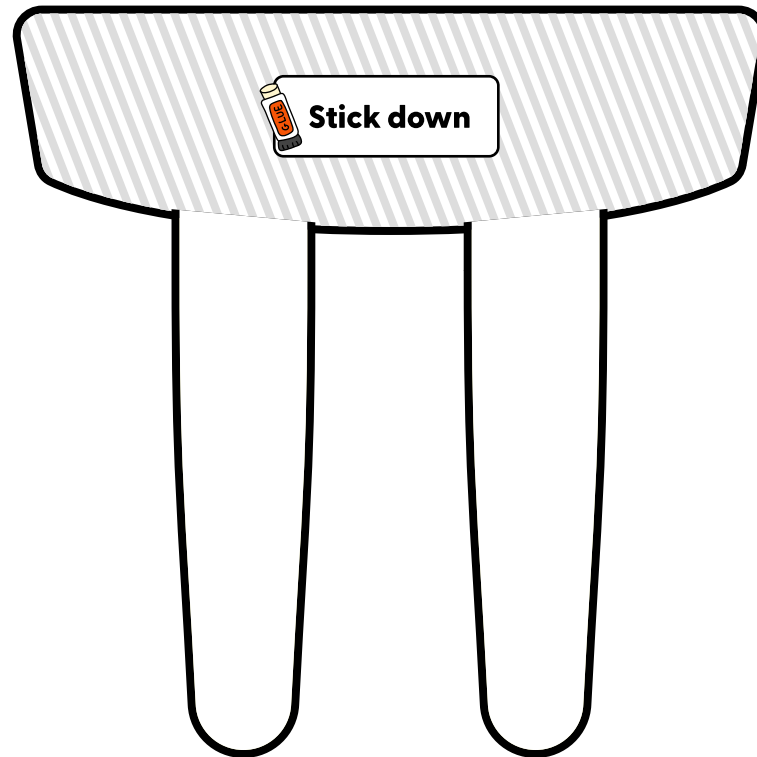

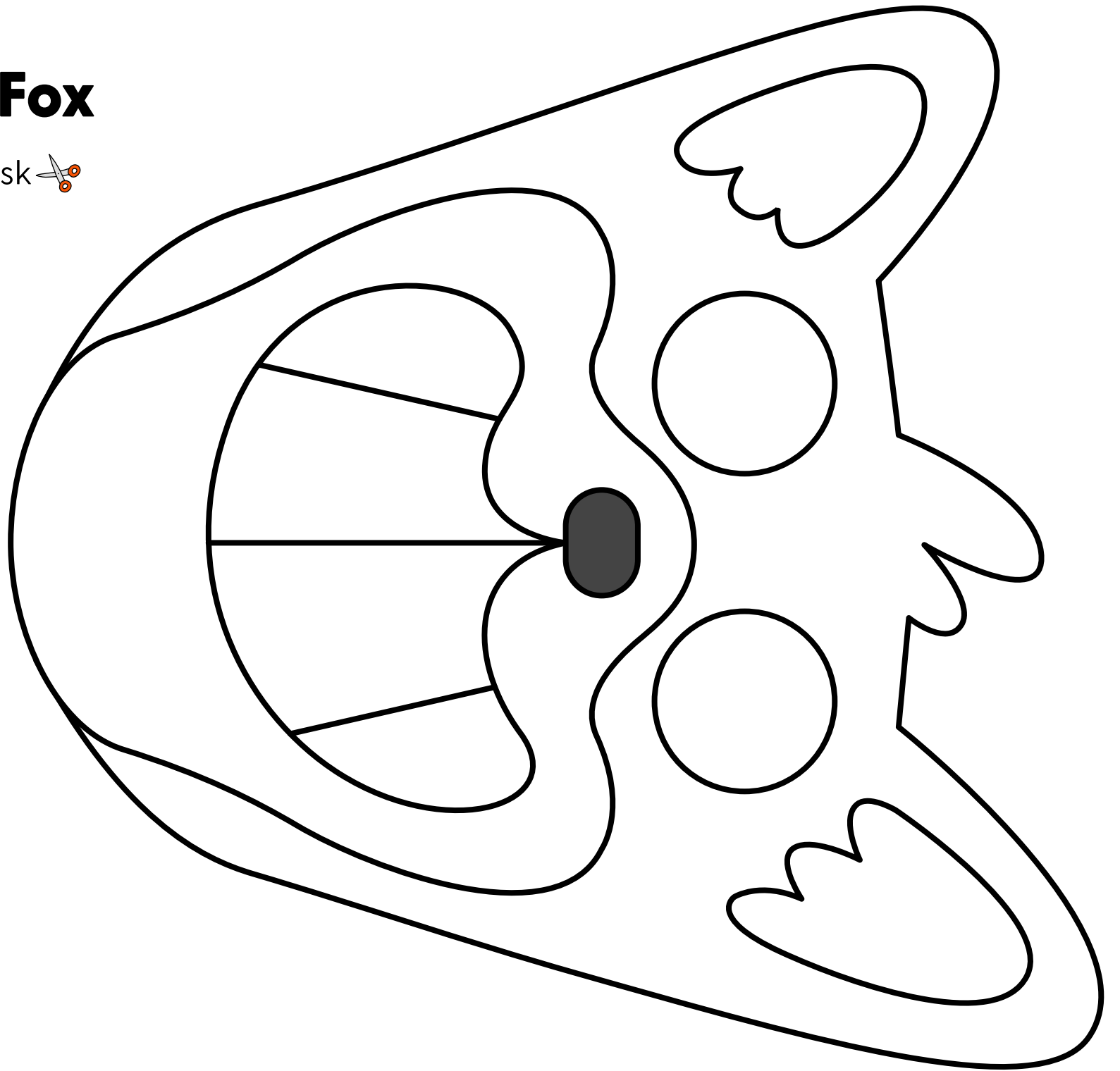
